By moving children and their activities outdoors, the character and type of what they do are transformed. Children regain control over their activities and become responsible for their own learning and growth, supported by attentive adults who ensure their safety and stimulation. Teachers relinquish control to become observers and supporters. (Approx. \$3,000) 2) **The American Montessori Society Conference is March 13<sup>th</sup>.** At CDSA, professional development is a priority for staff growth. This spring, the National AMS Conference will be in Dallas. Our goal is to be able to send 15 staff members. Registration is \$550.per staff member. We would like to raise 50% of this cost.
