#### Exploring Great Artists

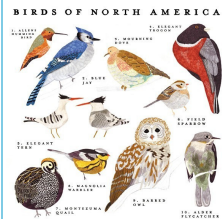

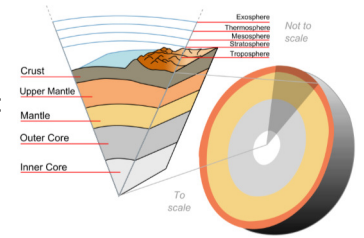


### Week 8: July 20 - July 24
